

HNL Audition Rules Agreement Form 2018

1. HNL is a community show. All performances must be **appropriate material** for all audiences, including young children. Audition judges and Bozeman Friends of Music reserve the right to edit material.
2. Any act that includes music with lyrics (bands, vocalists, dancers) **MUST** bring a legible copy of the lyrics to auditions. If you don't, you will lose your audition time slot.
3. All performers must be BHS or BAHS students. (Adult accompanists **MAY** be allowed if they are a minor part of the act. Please have this approved with Mr. Berdahl **BEFORE** coming to audition.)
4. Each member of the act is limited to a maximum number of five (5) acts that they can audition for. Exceptions must be pre-approved before auditions by Artistic Director Mr. Berdahl, and the Hawks Night Live Audition Committee.
5. All acts are limited to **3 minutes** and must be cut if necessary **BEFORE** auditions, you will be stopped at the three minute mark. Your act must be performance ready and performed **as you plan to perform** for the actual show including costumes and instruments. If you make changes in your act between your audition and Light and Sound checks, they will need to be approved! We will be thinking about staging, lighting and sound, etc. for your act during your audition!
6. Vocalists may not use pre-recorded music, unless it is an essential part of your act (for example, a comedy lip-sync).
7. **ON TIME ATTENDANCE** to all performers meetings, light and sound checks, and dress rehearsals is **MANDATORY**. Please check the schedule and make sure you will be available for all of these.
8. A student's privilege to participate in Hawks Night Live will be terminated if they come under disciplinary action at BHS, BAS or the court system.
